



Therapeutic Injections

Don't let pain keep you from living life to the fullest. We offer image-guided therapeutic injections to ease your discomfort and help you manage your pain.

Here's how therapeutic injections work:

- While you lie on an x-ray table, the area to receive the injection is cleansed and numbed with a local anesthetic.
- Next, the needle is inserted and dye is injected for the medical specialist to verify via a video monitor that the needle has been placed correctly.
- Then steroids are administered through the needle (possibly along with an anesthetic) to reduce the inflammation that is causing you pain.

Our therapeutic injection offerings include:

Epidural Steroid Injections: (MRI needed prior) Used to treat spinal degeneration, spinal stenosis and/or disc herniation; can be applied to all areas of the spine.

Facet or Sacroiliac Joint Injections: Applied to the facet joints (where the vertebrae slightly overlap one another on the spine) and to the sacroiliac joint (the area between the spine and pelvis).

Joint Injections: Can be performed on various joints, including the shoulder, hip & knee.
