- A. The Cooperative will install the necessary service wires from the road, street or alley, existing easement, or from the nearest pole of the Cooperative. The Customer's service location shall be such that the Cooperative can span its wires directly to the Point of Attachment of Customer's building or metering pole and connect same to Customer's service entrance wires in a manner where all wiring will be electrical code compliant. The Customer shall provide an approved location for attachment of the Cooperative's service wires that meets all safety and ground clearance requirements.
- B. The Cooperative will connect the Customer's service loop to the Cooperative's service wires and furnish, install and maintain the meter to be installed on Customer's premises.
- C. When a Customer desires energy to be delivered at a point or in a manner other than that specified by the Cooperative, the Customer will be assessed a charge equal to the additional cost of same, as set forth in Rule No. 7, the Cooperative's Line Extension rule.
- D. A service connection point or metering pole location on the Customer's premises will be designated by the Cooperative, and the Customer shall provide suitable space in a location approved by the Cooperative for the installation of the necessary metering equipment, which shall be located on the outside of the building or on the pole. Under no circumstances shall Metering Points be enclosed by the Customer in future development of the building. The Cooperative reserves the right to disconnect any meter that has been enclosed in additions to the building, until the Customer relocates the service point to the outside of the building.
- E. All meters shall be furnished, installed, owned and maintained by the Cooperative.
- F. The Cooperative reserves the right to seal all meter entrance switches and all Service-Entrance Boxes regardless of ownership, where the operation or tampering with may affect the registration of the meter or permit the use of energy contrary to the provisions of the applicable Rate Schedule.
- G. The Cooperative shall not be required to furnish service to a Customer until all permits are granted, and application has been accepted by a duly authorized agent of the Cooperative.
